1 The Board adopts this Code of Ethics as recommended by the Tennessee School Boards Association as a guide
2 to its members as they provide educational leadership for the youth of our state.

4 **ARTICLE I. MY RELATIONS TO THE CHILDREN**

6 Section 1. I will at all times think in terms of "children first," always determining other important
7 things according to how they affect education and the training of children.

9 Section 2. I will seek to provide equal educational opportunities for all children regardless of
10 ability, race, color, sex, creed, or location of residence.

12 **ARTICLE II. MY RELATIONS TO MY COMMUNITY**

14 Section 1. I will endeavor to appraise fairly both the present and future educational needs of the
15 community and to support improvements as finances permit.

17 Section 2. I will represent at all times the entire school community and refuse to represent
18 special interests or partisan politics.

20 Section 3. I will endeavor to keep the community informed about the progress and needs of the
21 schools.

23 **ARTICLE III. MY RELATIONS TO TEACHERS AND PERSONNEL**

25 Section 1. I will support the employment of those persons best qualified to serve as employees
26 and insist on a regular and impartial evaluation of all staff.

28 Section 2. I will support and protect personnel in the performance of their duties.
