1 Under the leadership and direction of the director of schools and the instructional supervisors, a unified
2 curriculum shall be developed within the statewide curriculum framework for the school system in each subject
3 area of grades K-12 and presented to the Board for adoption.¹

4
5 Teachers in each school shall participate in the system wide development of the curriculum in their appropriate
6 subject areas. The curriculum will be revised and updated regularly through in-service programs and
7 curriculum planning sessions, with changes subject to approval by the Board.

8
9 At least one copy of the complete curriculum shall be placed in each school or made available electronically.

10 Teachers shall have access to the portion which pertains to their area of teaching. New teachers shall be given
11 an appropriate copy and briefed by administration on its content in relation to the total curriculum.

12 13 **IMPLEMENTATION**

14
15 The primary responsibility for the effective operation of the curriculum program and activities shall be delegated
16 to the director of schools.

17
18 The school principals and instructional supervisors shall be responsible for administering the established
19 instructional programs and for the development and supervision of a coordinated plan for the improvement of
20 instruction in their schools.
