

# Wilson County Board of Education

1 The staff is authorized to take reasonable measures to establish appropriate school behavior. Any Wilson  
2 County School employee shall have the authority to control the conduct of any student while under the  
3 supervision of the school system. This authority shall extend to all activities of the school, including all games  
4 and public performances of athletic teams and other school groups, trips, excursions and all other activities  
5 under school sponsorship and direction.<sup>1</sup>

7 Such measures may include the use of reasonable force to restrain or correct students and maintain order.

8  
9 A student shall not use violence, force, noise, coercion, threat, intimidation, fear, passive resistance or any other  
10 conduct which causes the disruption, interference or obstruction of any school purpose while on school property,  
11 in school vehicles or buses or at any school sponsored activity, function or event, whether on or off campus.  
12 Neither shall she/he urge other students to engage in such conduct.

13  
14 Harassment, intimidation and other conduct that may be considered "bullying" (to include cyber bullying) will not  
15 be tolerated. Students shall not engage in conduct that has the effect of unreasonably interfering with another  
16 student's academic development or that creates a hostile or offensive learning environment. Bullying may  
17 include, but is not limited to, either physically harming another or damaging his/her property or knowingly placing  
18 another in reasonable fear.

19  
20 A student found guilty of misbehavior may receive punishment ranging from verbal reprimand to suspension  
21 and/or expulsion dependent on the severity of the offense and the offender's prior record.<sup>1</sup>
