- **What is a Strategic Plan?**
 - **Strategic plans are what many of you may remember as a School Improvement Plan. These are completed at both the district and school level. A strategic plan should provide an academic focus for the school year based upon the current status of the school/district in relation to the expectations and goals set forth per the Tennessee State Department of Education.**
- **Who approves a Strategic Plan?**
 - **The Tennessee Department of Education approves the district's Strategic Plan.**

#1

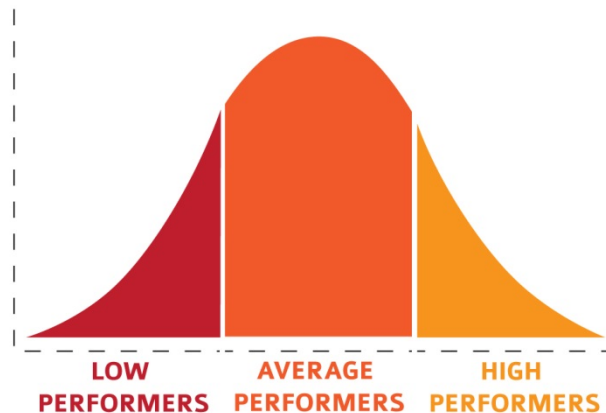
District will demonstrate expected or above expected growth through TVAAS in at least 25% of content areas.



Prioritized Goals

#2

District will maintain or improve its relative percentile rank in terms of %P/A in at least 25% of the content areas.



Prioritized Goals

#3

District will maintain or exceed its relative percentile rank for the Super Subgroup. *Super Subgroup refers to BHN, ELL, SWD, and ED as a combined group, counting a particular student only once.

#4

District will maintain or improve composite ACT score for the graduating class of 2016.

- **All schools must complete a strategic plan.**
- **Title I schools are required to electronically submit their Strategic Plan to the Tennessee Department of Education this school year.**
- **All schools will be required to electronically submit their Strategic Plan to the Tennessee Department of Education beginning with the 2016-17 school year.**
