# Challenge Yourself

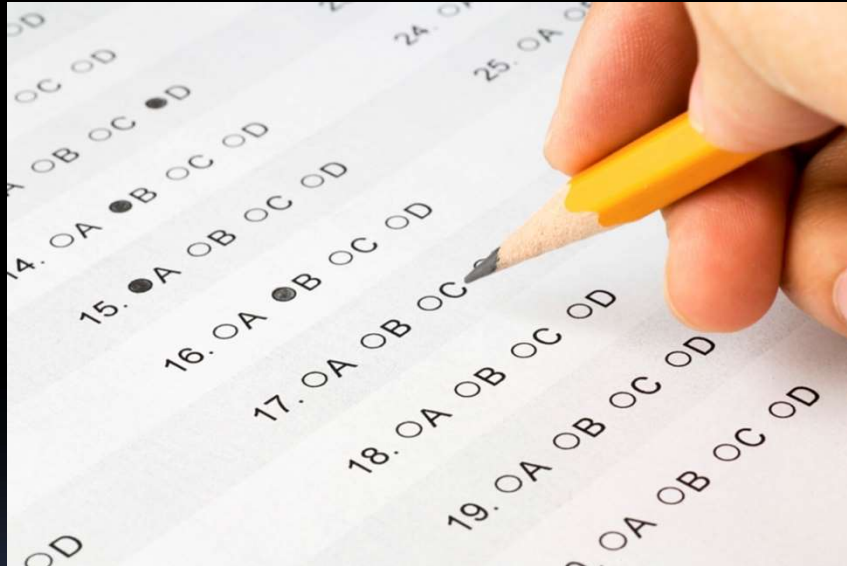
- \*Honors -3 points added to final grade and .5 quality points toward GPA
- \*AP classes – 5 points added to final grade and 1.0 quality point toward GPA upon completion of AP exam
- Dual Enrollment– 4 points added to final grade and 1.0 quality points toward GPA

\*If you sign up for Honors or AP classes, you will be obligated to take these classes.

- **If interested in Dual Enrollment, must take ACT this year.**

- Senior Year – Apply by 11/1
- Attend 1 mandatory meeting
- 8 hours of community service.

## HOPE Scholarship

- Approximately \$16,000 at 4 year TN college/university
- 3.0 Unweighted GPA or
- 21 on ACT


## **TN Scholar**

- **2.0 GPA**
- **80 hours of community service**
- **2 CTE, Fine Art, AP or Dual Enrollment credits**
- **95% Attendance**
- **No OSS**

# Graduating with Distinction

- 3.0 GPA or above and one of the following:
    - **Earn Industry Certification**
    - **Governor's School**
    - **Participate in All-State musical org.**
    - **National Merit Finalist or Semi-Finalist**
    - **ACT score of 31 or higher**
    - **Score 3 or higher on at least 2 AP exams**
    - **Earn 12 hours college credit**
    - **Statewide recognition or award from a statewide student organization**
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# Tri-Star Scholar

- Students who score a 19 or higher on the ACT plus earn an industry certification qualify

# No Student Rankings

## New Graduation Designations– Latin Honors

- Cum Laude – 3.75-3.99
- Magna Cum Laude – 4.0-4.24
- Summa Cum Laude – 4.25 and above

# Valedictorian and Salutatorian

- Must be enrolled in a WC HS min. 4 semesters
- Must qualify for the highest Latin System Honor
- Must sit for AP exam for every course enrolled and achieve 3 or above on 75% of AP exams
- Participate in 20 hours of community service
- If multiple students qualify, then the highest ACT composite will serve as the final determining criteria

# Student Athletes

- If you plan to attend a Division 1 or NCAA school and play a sport, no substitutions allowed.
- For example, Marketing/Mgmt. can not substitute for Economics.
