Wilson County Schools strives to ensure equitable digital access in order to promote challenging learning experiences. Our goal is to prepare students for future success.

Wilson County Schools acknowledges that students and employees benefit from digital resources while remaining within the bounds of safe, legal and responsible use. Students will receive a device for educational purposes. WCS is CIPA compliant. Student devices and accounts are monitored by WCS as needed. Teachers integrate technology for instruction, assignments, projects, research and assessment. This Student Device Agreement applies regardless of whether such use occurs on or off school district property.

Before Receiving Your Device

- Read and discuss the Acceptable Use Policy (Located on the wcschools.com webpage under "Student" tab)
- Read and discuss the Student Device Agreement with your Child
- Sign and return the Student Device Agreement to the Media Specialist at your school
- \$30 Annual Device Insurance

What will you receive?

- ★ Charge Cord (Replacement cost \$25.00 to be paid to the school)
- ★ Device- (No marks or stickers on device)

Frequently Asked Questions

Am I allowed to connect my home printer to my school device?

The use of home printers is not supported by the Wilson County School District.

What if my charge cord is lost?

Replacement cords must be purchased through the school at a cost of \$25.00's. This must to be paid to the school.

Is it a requirement for my student to bring his/her device home every night?

Yes. The device is the responsibility of the student. The device needs to return to school charged daily.

What types of social networking activities are considered appropriate?

No personal social networking sites such as Twitter, Facebook, etc. should be used on the device unless the classroom teacher allows media access to meet curriculum standards.

Will students keep devices over the summer break?

No. Students will turn in their laptop before summer break.

Will the devices have a webcam?

Devices have a webcam, but the webcam will be turned off.

Will the students be able to borrow a device if they leave their device at home?

No. The student must be responsible to bring their device to school daily, charged and ready to use.

What should a student do if their device is lost or stolen?

The student will have 24 hours once they realize it is gone to report the incident to their teacher, who will in turn report it to administrators.
