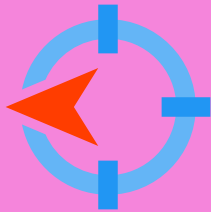
What You Need To Know

1 General Precautions

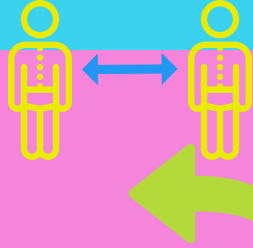


- Face coverings will be highly encouraged, especially during any time of transition and during arrival/dismissal .
- Students who ride the bus MUST wear a face covering.
- Teachers will be wearing face coverings if within 6ft of students.
- All classes will be cleaned and sanitized between each class change.

Transitions



- Classroom transitions will be handled in a controlled environment and students will go directly from one class to the next.
- There will be no lockers used this year.
- Bathroom breaks will occur during class time with one student at a time dismissed to go.

Dismissal

- Car riders will all be dismissed in a controlled environment and will exit out to the car rider lines.
- Buses will be loaded two at a time in an orderly fashion.

Arrival

- All students will have their temperature taken upon arrival; any temp at 100.4 or higher will be isolated.
- Students will be asked 4 system check questions; if student answers yes to any of the questions, they will be isolated and examined by the school nurse.
- Breakfast will be available, and students will be appropriately spaced within the cafeteria.
- Teachers will stay with their students in designated areas until dismissed to walk down to the classroom together.

- Students will have assigned seats in the cafeteria and will sit with their classmates.
- Students who go through the lunch line will be spaced apart and stay with their classmates.
