Below are a few updates for you. Short and sweet today!

- **Transportation Form:** You all should have received information from Bart Barker regarding transportation for next year. Completing this form to pre-register for 2023-24 bus service will allow transportation to build more efficient routes over the summer.

- **T-dap For Rising 7th Graders:** Rising 7th graders, it is not too early to beat the rush and get your T-dap immunization so there is no delay in starting back next year. You can fax the form or email it to Nurse Monica (garciam@wcschools.com or the fax is 615-754-7566 ATTN: Nurse Monica). Please see attachment for complete information. Wilson County Schools will also honor any religious or medical exemption pursuant to T.C.A. § 49-6-5001.
- **Chipotle Spirit Night:** It's **TONIGHT!** Please see the flyer on the last page.
- **Medication Pickup:** The beginning pickup date for all medications, supplies, snacks, etc. is May 11, 2023. Please only leave at school enough medication and supplies to cover through the end of the school year. All medications and supplies left at school after May 25, 2023, will be discarded by the nurse. A parent/guardian or adult designee will need to pick up medications and supplies. With the exception of inhalers, emergency epinephrine, and diabetic supplies, medications will not be given to students to transport home. No medications or supplies will be stored over the summer. You must speak with your school nurse to make arrangements for inhalers, emergency epinephrine, and diabetic supplies to be sent home with your student. They will be discarded if not picked up or alternate arrangements are not made. If your student will be participating in the summer learning program, it is your responsibility to ensure correct paperwork, medications, and supplies are delivered to the correct summer learning site. Medication will not be transported by school nurses to summer learning sites.

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Tennessee Department of Health (TDOH) has issued immunization requirements for those students entering 7th GRADE.

The following is required for your child to enter 7th GRADE:

___ Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis booster (Tdap)

Due to this being a statewide requirement, parents often have difficulty obtaining the required immunizations for their children. Because of this, you are strongly encouraged to make an appointment and get your child vaccinated as soon as possible.

Documentation of the above immunization must be submitted on the Tennessee Certificate of Immunization to the school nurse before your child enters seventh grade. Therefore, as soon as your child receives the necessary immunization(s), please turn the required documentation into the School Health Office to prevent any delays of your child entering the 7th grade. Wilson County Schools will also honor any religious or medical exemption pursuant to T.C.A. § 49-6-5001.

Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter. If you have any questions about the immunization requirements, please contact your school nurse.
